

Prospect Heights Middle School 6th Grade Supply List

- 2 1/2 (or 3"?) binder (no pockets if possible to help with organization)
- 2- 1 1/2" binder w/pockets
- 1- pencil pouch w/binder holes
- 3- sets of 5 dividers
- 1- pack colored pencils
- 1- pack of pencils (generic pencils do not sharpen well and are wasted)
- 2- pack loose leaf paper
- 1- pack of 3 glue sticks
- 1- pair of scissors
- 1- package of dry erase markers
- 3- plastic folders with pockets and clips in the middle
- 1- box of tissues
- 1- bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1- composition notebook
- 1- box of sandwich bags

Directions for 1st day: Do you want to start the year ready to go? Come to school with your Universal Binder ready.

Step 1: Place 1 set of dividers into your big, 3" binder. Label one Language Arts, one Science, one Math and leave the other dividers blank for now

Step 2: Place your pencil pouch in the clips in the front of your binder.

Step 3: Place 1 pack of loose leaf paper in the clips in the very back of your binder.

Step 4: In your pencil pouch place

- 1 pack of pencils
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- scissors
- glue sticks
- dry erase markers

Step 5: Make sure your name and homeroom teacher are written on the front of your binder and on all your supplies.

Step 6: Place name on the 1 1/2" binder for social studies

**Your tissues and hand sanitizer will go to your homeroom teacher.

*Individual teachers may request additional materials when school begins.
